



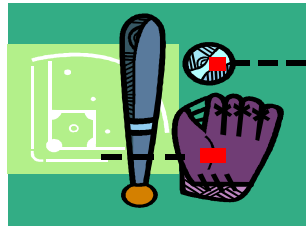

Town of Delafield 2010 Youth Baseball/Softball Registration

The Park and Recreation Commission has designated - **Friday, March 26, 6:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.**, and **Saturday, March 27, 10:00 a.m. – 12 p.m.**, as registration days for the 2010 youth baseball and softball program. The registration site is the Delafield Town Hall – N14 W30782 Golf Road. The program is open to Delafield city and town boys and girls - ages 5 to 17. Non-Delafield residents are also welcome to participate. Practices start in May, with league play scheduled to begin June 7th at the Sports Commons and Del-Town Park. A team shirt and cap are included in the registration fee. New players (ages 9-17) also require an original birth certificate or other government issued identification. Town of Delafield Residents

I arrived in Port Au Prince, Haiti on Sunday evening, January 10. My primary mission work was to install a hot water system for the Haitian Children's Home, an orphanage in Mirebalais, Haiti. The project began on Monday, January 11, and the earthquake occurred on Tuesday, January 12 at approximately 5:00 p.m. The school and its building, located about 35 miles over "Goat Mountain" from Port Au Prince (where the damage occurred), suffered very little damage. The buildings are constructed with concrete block and good reinforced concrete. They were built by U. S. and Canadian Christian volunteers. I was unable to finish the project and plan to return on April 14 to do so. The "Caprofors" Technical School, that we built, came thru in good shape. We are presently doing several storm water projects around their two main buildings. We hope to finish this work by early May, before their next rainy season.

While in Haiti, I reviewed several orphanages, schools and churches near Port Au Prince and several churches and school complexes in Mirebalais. They all sustained various degrees of damage, mainly minimal. I returned safely to Chicago by 10:30 a.m. on Sunday, February 7.

Thank you for all your positive thoughts, prayers and concerns for me and my family.
