

Dear Members of the Delafield Town Board:

We purchased the above property on Glen Cove Road in March 2017. Since we have lived at the above address the yard has been unusable from the months of Mid-October until mid-July. Throughout the summer there are many times when standing water or heavy rains prevents the use of the back yard for weeks at a time. This is due to the water from all properties from the east which pools in our yard and our neighbors, the Ceccato's, located at N20W29909 Glen Cove Rd. Pewaukee, WI 53072.

The current neighbors two houses to the east, the Nadolny's, located at N20W29917 Glen Cove Rd. Pewaukee Wi 53072, have mitigated the excessive water problem due to the previous owners being granted approval to connect to the storm system in 1998 according to Mr. Tim Barbeau, due to excessive water in their yard. These three houses are shown in figure 1 below.

The extent of the unusable yard is shown in extent in figures 2-8. These pictures are indicative of what the property looks like the majority of the year resulting in an unusable space. The grassy area is almost constantly saturated. When we attempt to walk through our yard, boots are a must as you sink a couple of inches due to the saturation or are walking through standing water.

The extent of the unusable yard due to saturated soil is outlined red in figure 9 (below). The orange outline indicates is the extent of the yard that is unusable because it is inaccessible due to excessive water. The blue outlined indicates the extent where Mr. Ceccato's yard is unusable/ inaccessible.

We are requesting permission from the town to connection into the storm water system, PWK1-22-1-4, at the drain located at the north west end of the property between the Ceccato's property and ours. The plan for our property is to create a rock bottom swale approximately 230 feet south of the storm drain, running in an east west fashion. The swale would collect the water from our residence then drain it to the storm water system. The storm water system drains 550 feet to the west into the wetland at a minor outflow. The creation of this swale and drainage system would be able to transfer the excess water from our property and not allow the excess water to enter the Ceccato's property. A rough sketch of what is proposed can be shown below in figure 10. The purple indicates the proposed area of the drainage swale. The blue arrow indicates the underground pipe transferring water from the drainage swale to the storm water system. The red dot is the catch basin for water to enter the underground pipe. The green dot is the entrance of the existing storm water system we are requesting to connect into. Figure 11 is a snapshot of the Town of Delafield NR 216 Modeling Map for the MS4 permit.

We have had several contractors visit our yard as well as Mr. Barbaeau to see the yard and excessive water first hand. All the contractors, have recommended tying into the storm water system, as this is existing and a precedent has been set for doing so. The contractors have not been able to determine an economical, efficient, and realistic way other than utilizing the existing storm water system.

We are looking forward to a quick resolution to our drainage issues to allow us to gain full use of our yard.
