A. Discussion and possible action on Technical Rescue Service Contract between the Town of Delafield and City of Waukesha

Chief Kozlowski stated that the Town has been under contract with the City of Waukesha since 2003. Since that time, the Town has not called them in for technical rescue services. If we decide we do not want them under contract and would need their services, the cost would be 5 times what is currently charged. The Town is very reliant on the City of Waukesha for these services. In order to avoid paying for services we are not utilizing, his advice would be to adopt a chargeback allowance ordinance.

MOTION MADE BY MR. KRANICK, SECONDED BY MR. SMITH TO NOT APPROVE THE CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF WAUKESHA, AND DIRECT STAFF TO DRAFT A CHARGEBACK ORDINANCE TO BE REVIEWED BY THE TOWN ATTORNEY AND BROUGHT BACK TO THE TOWN BOARD FOR CONSIDERATION. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION MADE BY MR. KRANICK, SECONDED BY MR. SMITH TO TAKE ITEM 8C OUT OF ORDER. MOTION CARRIED.

C. Discussion and possible action on sale of fire department trailer.

MOTION MADE BY MR. SMITH, SECONDED BY MR KRANICK TO SELL THE 1999 FIRE DEPARTMENT TRAILER FOR \$1700.00. MOTION CARRIED.

B. Discussion and possible action on Ordinance to Repeal Section 12.03(3)(f) 1.e. of the Town of Delafield Municipal Code Concerning Fingerprinting and Photographing of Operator's Licensees

MOTION MADE BY MR. SMITH, SECONDED BY MR. KRANICK, TO APPROVE THE ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTION 12.03(3)(F) 1.E. OF THE TOWN OF DELAFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING FINGERPRINTING AND PHOTOGRAPHING OF OPERATOR'S LICENSEES. MOTION CARRIED.

D. Discussion and possible action on Proposal for Roof Specifications for Town of Delafield Garage

Engineer Barbeau directed attention to a proposal from Industrial Roofing Services, Inc. to serve as a rep. for the installation of a roof on the Town of Delafield Garage. The proposal includes all services necessary to furnish system analysis and selection, system design and project administration at a rate of 7% of the lowest responsible bid received (\$2500 minimum fee). He stated the importance of utilizing this type of expertise in selecting and installing a roof system that will meet long term needs.

Dave Angove spoke on behalf of Industrial Roofing Services, Inc., stating that their company has been in business for over 20 years and has performed services for other municipalities. PHASE I of the proposed project could be completed in approximately 4 weeks. An interview process will occur with Town staff to meet all expectations.

MOTION MADE BY MR. KRANICK, SECONDED BY MR. SMITH TO APPROVE THE PROPOSAL FROM INDUSTRIAL ROOF SERVICES, DATED APRIL 30, 2018, CONTINGENT UPON REFERENCE CHECKS AND CORRECTION OF TYPOGRAPHICAL ERRORS IN THE PROPOSAL. MOTION CARRIED.

E. Discussion and possible action on Plan Commission's recommendation for Patricia Mayer Revocable Trust of 2012 Revocable Trust to add a 33-foot wide reservation along the west side of proposed Lots 1 and 2 on a previously approved, but not recorded, Certified Survey Map located at S11 W30520 Summit Avenue

Engineer Barbeau stated that the Plan Commission recommended approval of the request for a 33 foot reservation of land on the west side of lots 1 and 2 on the Mayer property from USH 18, to the north end of the property, and also a 20' dedication of additional Row adjacent to Lot 1 along USH 18.

MOTION MADE BY MR. KRANICK, SECONDED BY MR. SMITH TO RE-APPROVE THE CERTIFIED SURVEY MAP DATED MAY 9, 2017, FOR PATRICIA MAYER REVOCABLE TRUST OF 2012 THAT INCLUDES AN ADDITIONAL 20 FOOT DEDICATION ADJACENT TO LOT 1 ON USH 18, AND A 33 FOOT RESERVATION ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF LOTS 1 AND 2, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE PLAN COMMISSION, SUBJECT TO THE ADDITION OF THE FOLLOWING NOTES ON THE CSM:

1. THE RESERVATION IS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE TOWN OF DELAFIELD FOR FUTURE ROAD PURPOSES AND IS LOCATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE WISDOT ACCESS MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR USH 18.

- 2. THE RESERVATION SHALL BE OFFERED FOR 100 YEARS OR UNTIL SUCH TIME THAT A ROADWAY IS CONSTRUCTED IN THE RESERVATION AREA AND THE LAND IS ACCEPTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF DELAFIELD.
- 3. UNTIL SUCH TIME THAT THE TOWN ACCEPTS THE RESERVATION, THE OWNER OF THE LAND SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO USE AND MAINTAIN THE LAND CONSISTENT WITH THE UNDERLYING ZONING, EXCEPT THAT NO STRUCTURES SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED WITHIN THE RESERVATION AREA, SUBJECT TO REVIEW OF THESE NOTES BY THE TOWN ATTORNEY. MOTION CARRIED.
- F. Consideration and possible action on approval of Developer's Agreement for White Oak Conservancy

Engineer Barbeau reviewed suggested changes by the Town Attorney.

MOTION MADE BY MR. SMITH, SECONDED BY MR. KRANICK TO APPROVE THE DEVELOPER'S AGREEMENT FOR WHITE OAKS CONSERVANCY SUBJECT TO INCORPORATING CHANGES AND FINAL REVIEW BY STAFF. MOTION CARRIED.

G. Consideration and possible action on request for waiver of the suspension of the Conditional Use Permit moratorium

Engineer Barbeau stated that there is an allowance for a day care in the original Church of the Resurrection Conditional Use. Lake County Childcare has applied for a Conditional Permit to run a daycare in the existing unused space that has been leased for many years. The owners applied during the period in which the Town set a three month moratorium on the issuance of CUP's, beginning February 13 and are requesting that the Town Board grant an exception to the terms of the moratorium. The Plan Commission is in favor of this request.

MOTION MADE BY MR. SMITH, SECONDED BY MR. KRANICK TO GRANT A WAIVER FROM THE CONDITIONAL USE MORATORIUM FOR THE CHURCH OF THE RESURRECTION ONLY BECAUSE A SIMILAR OR SAME CONDITIONAL USE HAS BEEN IN USE BY THIS LOCATION IN THE PAST. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION MADE BY CHAIRMAN KRAUSE, SECONDED BY MR. SMITH TO RE-APPOINT EDWARD KRANICK FOR ANOTHER YEAR TO SERVE ON THE PLAN COMMISSION. CHAIRMAN KRAUSE – AYE, MR. SMITH – AYE, MR. KRANICK – ABSTAINED. MOTION CARRIED.
