A. Nathan Holoubek, DNR, follow-up discussion on deer population control/nuisance tags

Nathan Holoubek, DNR, stated that he is here for "open book" questions on deer population control and to provide a re-cap on deer nuisance permits. Last year, the Town was provided 50 tags for public hunting use. The DNR received many calls from hunters, due to confusion on procedures. He stated that the DNR is in the process of developing an informational brochure on requirements for bow hunter use of deer harvest authorization permits. The tags were valid during the legal hunting season. Only 11 out of the 50 obtained were harvested that included: 7 bucks, 3 male fawns and 1 female doe. Mr. Holoubek suggested that the Town identify "hot spots" and work with landowners on harvesting methods. He stated that Lapham Peak is an exception because the land is restricted by a warranty deed.

The clerk was directed to meet with Mr. Holoubek to review necessary procedures/requirements for obtaining nuisance permits and follow up procedures with applicants.

Kathy Gutenkunst, Glen Cove Rd., stated that she lives directly behind the Thomas Rd. She has lost several trees and bushes and is of the opinion that the deer are dangerous. Bow hunting will not solve the problem, and she is recommending removal of the deer by sharpshooting. In the many years she has resided in the Town, this deer population problem is out of control.


