

Engineer Barbeau stated that the position of staff is this is a private culvert on private property, and the road water is not all Town's water. It comes from the Arbor's subdivision and flows through the subject area. Property owners are responsible for their private culverts. Mr. Roberts stated that he would be in favor of cleaning out the pipe under Maple Avenue and installing rip-rap in the right-of-way area.

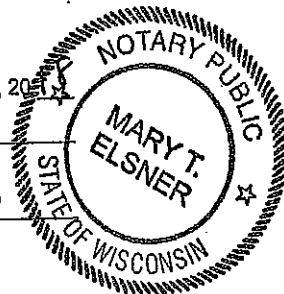
