

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-002

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE PROVISIONS OF  
THE TOWN OF DELAFIELD MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING  
THE TOWN PARK AND RECREATION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that it would be beneficial to change the structure of the Park and Recreation Commission membership; and,

WHEREAS, the Board hopes to interest more citizens in serving on the Commission by reducing the length of members' terms from seven years to two and reducing the size of the Commission to make it less unwieldy.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board for the Town of Delafield, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

Section 1.21(3) is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

(3) MEMBERSHIP. (a) The Commission shall consist of seven (7) members. The membership shall be comprised of one (1) Town Supervisor and six (6) citizen members. The Commission members shall be appointed by the Town Chair, subject to confirmation by the Town Board. All members shall be residents of the Town.

The six citizen members' terms shall be for three (3) years beginning on the first Monday in May of each year. The terms for the citizen members shall be staggered. The initial term for two of the citizen members shall be one year, the initial term of two of the citizen members shall be two years and the initial term of two of the citizen members shall be three years. Following the initial terms, the terms for the citizen members shall be three years.

The Town Supervisor member shall serve a one year term beginning on the first Monday in May of each year and shall act as a liaison between the Town and the Commission.

- (b) Officers. The Commission shall elect a chairperson and a vice-chairperson. The Town Clerk or Town Clerk's designee shall act as secretary and record minutes of Commission meetings.
- (c) Official Oath. Official oaths shall be taken by all members in accordance with section 19.01, Wis. Stats., within 10 days of receiving written notice from the Town Clerk of their appointment.
- (d) Vacancies. Vacancies on the Commission shall be filled by appointment by the Town Chair and confirmed by the Town Board. Such an appointee shall serve

the balance of the term of the member that the appointee replaces.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.


The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinance whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
