

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTIONS 12.03(3)(b)(3),
12.03(3)(e)(3), AND 12.03(10)(c) OF THE TOWN OF DELAFIELD
MUNICIPAL CODE, RELATED TO ALCOHOL BEVERAGE LICENSES
ISSUED TO EVENTS HELD AT MULTIPLE LOCATIONS

WHEREAS, on or about October 23, 2015, Wisconsin State laws were amended by 2015 Wisconsin Act 62, to allow the issuance of multiple temporary retail alcohol beverage licenses for multiple locations, under the limited circumstances described within the new State laws, thereby allowing such events that are commonly referred to as a "beer walk" or "wine walk"; and

WHEREAS, this change to State laws gives rise a need to update the Town of Delafield Municipal Code, to ensure that the Town Code is consistent with State law as required by Wisconsin Statutes Section 125.10.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Delafield, Waukesha, Wisconsin, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 12 of the Town of Delafield Municipal Code entitled "Licenses and Permits," Section 12.03 entitled "Alcohol Beverages," subsection (3) entitled "Classes of Licenses and Fees," subsection (b) entitled "Class 'B' Fermented Malt Beverage Retailers License," subsection (3) entitled "Temporary - Special Event (Picnic)," is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

3. Temporary – Special Event (Picnic). Available to certain bona fide clubs, chambers of commerce, fair associations, agricultural societies, churches, lodges or societies that have been in existence for 6 months or more. See §125.26(6), Wis. Stats.

SECTION 2: Chapter 12 of the Town of Delafield Municipal Code entitled "Licenses and Permits," Section 12.03 entitled "Alcohol Beverages," subsection (3) entitled "Classes of Licenses and Fees," subsection (e) entitled "Retail 'Class B' Liquor License," subsection (3) entitled "Temporary - Special Event License," is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

3. Temporary – Special Event License. Available to certain bona fide clubs, chambers of commerce, fair associations, agricultural societies, churches, lodges or societies that have been in existence for 6 months or more. See §125.51(10), Wis. Stats. The amount of the license fee shall be as set forth from time to time by resolution of the Town Board, except that no fee shall be charged if the person applies at the same time for a Class "B" license under §12.03(3)(b)(3). for the same event. Not more than 2 licenses may be issued under this subsection to qualified groups under §125.51(10)(a), Wis. Stats., in any 12 month period, except for multiple-license events that may be allowed per Section 125.51(b), Wis. Stats.
