

Resolution No. 15-616

A Resolution to establish a speed zone on Maple Avenue between North Shore Drive and a point 225 feet south of the centerline of Franciscan Road in the Town of Delafield, Waukesha County Wisconsin

WHEREAS, the developer of Woodridge Estates and Woodridge Estates II, Neumann Properties, has requested that the Town Board consider reducing the speed limit on Maple Avenue between Franciscan Road and North Shore Drive from 45 mph to 35 mph, and

WHEREAS, State Statute 349.11 provides authority to the Town to set speed limits on Town roads, and

WHEREAS, the current speed limit south of Franciscan Road is 30 mph and the current speed limit in the section of roadway under consideration is 45 mph, and

WHEREAS, the Town Engineer has studied the portion of Maple Avenue where the speed limit reduction is requested and has determined that due to the additional traffic that will be added to Maple Avenue due to the Woodridge Estates and Woodridge Estates II subdivision, and to provide a reasonable, prudent and safe driving speed for users of the roadways, a reduction of the speed limit is warranted, and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2015 the Town Board considered the recommendation of the Town Engineer and approved a motion to make the change to the speed limit, and

WHEREAS, the roadway connection to Maple Avenue from the Woodridge Estates subdivisions is under construction and is anticipated to be open for travel no later than October 1, 2015,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF DELAFIELD THAT:

A speed zone is established as follows: 35mph on Maple Avenue between North Shore Drive and a point 225 feet south of Franciscan Road.

The Highway Superintendent, in conformity with Chapter 349 of the State Statutes, shall place the necessary speed limit signs to give adequate warning to users of the roadway, and no provision of the traffic code (Chapter 7) of the Town of Delafield Municipal Code with respect thereto, shall be enforceable unless and until such signs are erected and in place and sufficiently legible to be seen by an ordinary observant person.

All resolutions or parts thereof that are inconsistent with or contravening this resolution are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk shall file this resolution in the official records of the Town of Delafield.
