

RESOLUTION NO. 16-625A RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT TO EXERCISE POLICE POWER
AUTHORITY FOR SPECIAL ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, the Town is authorized by Section 66.0703, Wis. Stats., to collect special assessments upon property in a limited and determinable area for special benefits conferred upon such property by any municipal work or improvement; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Attorney has determined that 2nd Alley, shown on the Map of Johnsons Park subdivision, recorded May 17, 1922, is a public street, and

WHEREAS, 2nd Alley requires construction, reconstruction and repair to provide health, safety and welfare of residents using the public street, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Delafield has determined that the construction, reconstruction and repair of 2nd Alley shall be assessed to abutting property owners,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Delafield, Waukesha County, Wisconsin:

SECTION 1: The Town Board hereby declares its intention to exercise its police power authority under Section 66.0703, Wis. Stats., to levy special assessments upon property in a limited and determinable area for special benefits conferred upon such property by the construction of improvements in the following locations:

SECTION 2: The number of installments will be determined at the Public Hearing required by Section 66.0703, Wis. Stats.

SECTION 3: The Town Engineer is directed to prepare a report consisting of:

Preliminary plans and specifications for said improvements;
An estimate of the entire cost of the improvements; and
A reasonable method of conferring the special assessment and an estimate of police power special assessments for each tax parcel in the above-described special assessment district.

Upon completion of such report, the Town Engineer is directed to file a copy thereof in the Town Clerk's office for public inspection.
